


ARB FRIDGE FREEZER

The ARB Fridge Freezer has 35 liters of space. When you pick up the van the fridge is set to cool to 37 degrees Fahrenheit. This is the best temperature to keep everything cold without freezing items at the bottom of the fridge. The fridge also monitors the camper van's battery and will shut off before damaging the battery and preventing the van from starting.

- To **Power On** the ARB Fridge Freezer, press and hold the Power Button until the LED lights up green. The display will show the current cabinet temperature.
- To set the target cabinet temperature of your ARB Fridge Freezer, press the menu button until a temperature is displayed. Then use the plus or minus sign to change the target temperature. After 5 to 6 seconds of inactivity, the display will flash twice to store temperature.







Control Panel from Left to Right

- 1) Power On and Off
- 2) Boost Button (Only use with van on)
- 3) Status/Error Indication LED
- 4) Digital Temperature Display
- 5) Menu Button
- 6) Temperature Up
- 7) Temperature Down
- The power save mode on the fridge is activated when the voltage of the van batteries drops below a certain level. We set up the vans to ensure they run throughout the trip and batteries are not depleted by the fridge drawing too much power.
- During the hot summer months, the fridge will pull more battery power to keep the fridge to the desired cooling temperature. If you leave the van parked during the summer, crack a window.

TIP:

• If the van was parked all day, running the van for 20-30 minutes will help to charge up the batteries.
